

# Introducing BiblioBoard

The Fresno County Public Library is proud to announce that it now offers **BiblioBoard Library** free to all its customers.

BiblioBoard Library is an easy-to-use platform that allows the Library to offer high quality content to customers, on the web and on eReaders. BiblioBoard Library hosts content from traditional publishers, indie authors, cultural institutions and local thought leaders. Users can access BiblioBoard Library through the Library's website or on the device of their choice, including the iPad®, iPad® mini, Kindle Fire® HD, Galaxy Tab®, Nexus® and more.

The BiblioBoard Core collection contains over 23,000 full-text eBooks and other multi-media content, curated in over 400 anthologies across a range of topics. Because there are no limits on simultaneous use, you'll never be put on a hold list and you can check out eBook titles for as long as you like!

In addition to this collection, Library customers will have access to multimedia anthologies curated by the Fresno County Public Library and the SELF-e and Indie California local author collections.

## How to Use

To use BiblioBoard at a Fresno County Public Library branch:

- Visit BiblioBoard on any device with a web browser and Internet access, including library computers and laptops or personal phones, tablets, or computers.
- Create a BiblioBoard account and log in, to ensure that any bookmarks and notes are saved.

To access BiblioBoard outside of the Library, you will need:

- A Fresno County Public Library card
- Internet access
- For mobile devices, the BiblioBoard app for [Android tablets](#) or [iPads](#). Please note: the BiblioBoard Android app is not compatible with Android phones; the iOS app is not available for the iPhone or iPod Touch.
- Any current web browser
- A BiblioBoard account. You can create a free account on the BiblioBoard site.

## How do I check out and read an eBook from BiblioBoard?

## How can I save books to read offline?

Offline access is only available via the BiblioBoard app.

To download a book for offline access, tap the bookshelf icon next to any book to download it. Yellow bookshelf icons indicate that a book has been added to the offline bookshelf. You can also remove a book from the online bookshelf by tapping the yellow bookshelf icon next to it.

**I've written a book. Can I submit it to SELF-e or Indie CA?**

To submit your book, please visit Fresno County Public Library's SELF-e submission portal. Files must be submitted in ePub2, ePub3, or PDF format.

You can use BiblioBoard's [Pressbooks](#) feature to put your work in eBook format.
