FRESNO COUNTY, CA – Fresno County residents are invited to join Fresno County Reads, the Library's annual community reading program for all ages. This year's selection is Finding Gobi by Dion Leonard, the heartwarming true story of an ultramarathon runner and the stray dog who changed his life.

As part of the program, residents will have the opportunity to meet both Dion and his dog Gobi during special author events at select Library branches this October.

With companion editions for teens and children, Dion Leonard invites readers of all ages to connect with Gobi's unforgettable journey.

Running now through the end of November, Fresno County Reads encourages residents to read one book as a community and come together for related programs and discussions. More information, including registration for events, can be found at www.fresnolibrary.org.

Free Access to the Book

Through the Library's digital service Libby, Finding Gobi is available in "infinity mode," meaning every Fresno County Public Library cardholder can download a free digital copy with no wait time. Residents who enjoy reading a physical book can check their local Library branch for an available copy or use the Library's website to reserve a book and have it sent to their preferred location.
