Kingsburg Library to Temporarily Close for Flooring and Lighting Upgrades

Fresno County, CA – The Kingsburg Library will temporarily close beginning March 23rd to allow for facility improvements. The library is expected to reopen in early May.

During the closure, crews will replace flooring in the public spaces of the library and update the building's lighting to LED lighting. The new flooring will improve the appearance and durability of the library's public areas, while the upgraded lighting will provide brighter, more efficient illumination throughout the space. The work requires full access to the building so construction crews can complete the project as quickly, efficiently, and safely as possible.

While the Kingsburg Library is closed, patrons may return materials to the book drop located in the parking lot behind the library.

The closest Fresno County Public Library locations open during the closure are the Fowler Library and the Reedley Library, and community members are encouraged to visit those locations for in person services. A vast array of online services, including access to eBooks and audiobooks, are available through the library's website at fresnolibrary.org.

Holds normally picked up at the Kingsburg Library will be rerouted to the Reedley Library during the temporary closure. Patrons can also update their preferred pickup location on their account page on the library's website.

These improvements are part of a countywide effort to update library facilities and ensure continued access to library services in the future. The project is funded through the voter approved library tax Measure B, which supports library services and facility improvements across Fresno County. The Fresno County Public Library appreciates the community's patience while these improvements are completed.
